Preliminary discussion on cemetery lot purchase variances:

Consideration of DNR Master Plan Draft response letter: Skare read the draft letter after which it was reviewed by the board. Recommended changes were:

- O Add town met with DNR & Peninsula Park officials about 4 years ago about a multimodal trail along Hwy 42 from the existing Gibraltar School trail to the Ephraim limits. A memorandum of understanding was drafted by the DNR and signed by the town at that time.
- o Sanitary District spent in excess of \$50,000 to accommodate the park in moving lift station #3.
- o Reference MOU and attach as an exhibit
- o Attach costs for Shore Road in the Hwy 42 project and what was being asked of the town

Motion: (Johnson, Daubner) to send the letter with the modifications mentioned. <u>Carried</u>

2019 WPS Main line upgrade through town:

- o Bob Leskowski of WPS stated this section is due for an upgrade due to age and capacity issues
- o Will be done spring or fall.
- Options are open all underground, trident poles, regular poles, underground crossings
- o \$500,000 to upgrade the line
- o Trident poles alone \$400,000
- o Undergrounding crossing \$750,000
- o Whole underground \$3,000,000
- o WPS cannot make someone take underground service
- o Boring the road is \$40-50 per foot.
- o Spruce Street to Gibraltar Road existing poles will be replaced town choice wood/trident or combination
- o Transformers may be needed if lines are put underground
- o Estimated life of the wire is 40 years
- o Maintenance is easier overhead for WPS
- o Individuals/businesses could opt to go underground at their own expense
- o Patrick to contact Bob with problem areas for snow removal

Preliminary beer wagon discussion: Skare stated the topic came up during liquor license renewals.

- o Different than food truck
- o Its more about if allowed should it be by special event request or by mapped area
- o An event request keeps the playing field fair
- o Private events ask for special event request
- o Skare will contact WGI regarding their cart
