RED CROSS HOME FIRE PREPAREDNESS CAMPAIGN

The Red Cross launched the Red Cross Home Fire Preparedness Campaign with the goal to reduce home fire deaths and injuries by 25% over a 5-year period. Red Cross research has identified the population groups at the highest risk for fire death and injury, which include:

- Low-income individuals and families
- Seniors over age 65
- Youth under age 18
- English as a Second Language individuals
- Individuals with disabilities or access and functional needs
- Individuals who live in a geographic area with high historical incidences of home fires, deaths, or injuries

Families or individuals who fall within these categories are welcomed and encouraged to call the Gibraltar Fire Department for a home check. During the home check, a member of the Fire Department will test existing smoke detectors, replace batteries, install up to three smoke detectors (one for each level) and conduct fire safety education for the occupants. Smoke detector checks and maintenance will be performed as resources allow and so long as the smoke detector is within reach of a 6' ladder.

Availability of resources is limited, and the program will conclude when all resources have been used. If you qualify for the program, add your name to the list by calling the Gibraltar Fire Department at 868-3820.
