

**INTRODUCTORY REMARKS
GIBRALTAR PLAN COMMISSION**

I. CALL TO ORDER

This meeting or the Gibraltar Plan Commission is called to order.

II. GREETING AND INTRODUCTIONS

Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. This is a hearing conducted by the Gibraltar Plan Commission. My name is Linda Merline (commission members will introduce themselves). Beth Hagen will serve as clerk this evening.

III. PURPOSE

The purpose of this hearing is to gather testimony on the various cases on tonight's agenda. You are encouraged to explain how your interests are affected, how the public is affected, and to bring out any facts pertinent to the case related to public health, safety, convenience, and general welfare.

IV. TYPES OF CASES

The type of case on tonight's agenda are that of application for conditional use.

Our commission will conduct a hearing and make a recommendation to the town board of the Town of Gibraltar to either support, support a modified version of the petition, not support or stand mute on the petition. The town board will make the final recommendation to the Resource Planning Committee on the application for conditional use.

V. PROCEDURE

The procedure, which we will use, this evening to conduct the hearings is as follows: I will give an explanation of the case. Gibraltar Plan Commission members will then report on any on-site inspections or other background information they have.

There will be two rounds of testimony from those of you in attendance. The applicant will go first followed by others in favor. Those in opposition will speak second. Persons with only questions should speak as if they are in opposition.

The second round is for purpose of rebuttal. Only those who spoke in the first round may speak in rebuttal.

Because of the need to prepare a clear record of your testimony, I ask that only one person come to the table at a time.

If you want to testify, please come forward, state your name and address and then present your testimony. Statements from the back of the room and exchanges between parties will not be allowed. Speakers presenting repetitive or irrelevant testimony will be excused from the table. Following this evening's hearings, the commission will adjourn to its regular business meeting. You may observe those proceedings but may not participate in the commission's hearing decision.
