## **Discuss Town Shop, Airport and Fire Department Walk-throughs:**

Town Shop: Nothing new to report

Airport: Nothing new to report

Fire Department:

- Weather stripping on bay door #2, on the east side needs to be addressed within the regular maintenance budget. Damaged last year.
- Spray seal concrete
- Clean main doors. Grease leaking from door springs.
- Outside soffit lamp south of the office, needs a new light and cleaning
- Shower vents in the bathroom (ERV). Do they work or are they shut off for efficiency? Guillette to inspect.
- Storage for exhaust fixtures upstairs, could be stored in cold storage if there is room.
- 5 entry LED troughers \$265.15/ea
- Need to budget for more bay lamps. \$62.00/each (would like to budget for 24)

Motion: (Sohns/Birmingham) to recommend to the Town Board to proceed with the Expansion Joint repair this year with an additional \$2175 for tuckpointing, using money from the Capital Improvement fund, due to the cost savings of doing the work together. <u>Carried.</u>

**Old Town Hall Bathrooms:** The showers in the Old Town Hall bathrooms are underutilized. Would make better sense to remove the showers and add additional stalls. There is considerable usage on the weekends and extra stalls are needed. But the restrooms/showers are still in good condition and shouldn't be a priority for next year.

**Determine Priorities for 2014 Budget:** The committee reviewed last year's priorities and made adjustments to include this year.

**Follow-up on Previous Walk-throughs:** The Dock bathrooms need to be addressed and the back fire door at the Town Center needs to be adjusted to close properly.

**Other Lighting/Maintenance Issues:** *Motion: (Sohns/Birmingham) to have Mike's Water Tight Gutters install an eave trough above the A/C Unit at the Town Hall.* <u>*Carried*</u>
