- Futures map with potential parks and streets - questionable
- Develop guidelines to maximize protection and stewardship of wooded areas
- More public access to Green Bay shoreline
- County Burn Ordinance in brochure rack and Burn permitting information to be included in Spring newsletter
- Compatible land use with surrounding municipalities to protect rural character/countryside
- Posting of land use changes/petitions
