Discuss Library Book Drop Options: Holly Somerhalder was present to discuss the options available for location of the book cart. The steps in the Children's room would make maneuvering a cart difficult. She suggests/prefers another book drop, considering the current one lasted 30+ years. It has been repaired several times and is now rusting from the outside and the lock is difficult. She presented options for new book drops that would work for them. She thinks the current cart may be utilized with the new stainless steel box or the painted book return option, would include a cart.

Motion: (Birmingham/ Sohns) to recommend to the Town Board to purchase a new box. Preferably the Stainless steel option. <u>Carried.</u>

Gibraltar Town Shop Recommendation: Stubenvol was asked by Merkel to get all the plans for a new town shop in order. The dimensions of the plan received from Baileys Harbor are suitable for our use. The stone veneer is not necessary.

Things to consider: Compressed air, emergency eye wash station, shower, storage, exhaust system and LED *Motion: (Sohns/ Stubenvoll) to recommend the Baileys Harbor plan to the Gibraltar Town Board with 3 bays, a uniformed roof line and footprint. Project cost is approximately \$450,000; which includes septic, well, surveyor and driving surfaces. Carried.*

Follow-up on Previous Walk-throughs: Maintenance staff has been completing many of the small tasks on the building committee's list. Need to monitor the door at the annex this winter.
