Curt Campbell suggested the tree that needs to be moved from the neighboring (Volz) property. Andrea Kinsey-Jauquet will contact Meissner's Landcaping regarding planting of trees and will contact Eunice Rutherford of GHA for her opinion. Andrea Kinsey-Jauquet requested that Paul Woerfel get the advice from the Harbor Commission regarding planting a tree to shade the entrance to the public restrooms at the dock.

Tim Biwer stated that a tree could be planted to replace the Apple tree in Clark Park.

It was moved by Pat Spielman and seconded by Curt Campbell to adjourn and the meeting adjourned at 10:45 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.
