Harris spoke with Kahr about raising the fuel dock. He will probably get to it this week. He is aware of the electrical wires and will use caution. He will also be raising the docks on Chambers Island. He will also provide an estimate to raise the height of the main dock with fill.

**Public Comment:** None

**2020 Reservation Confirmation Wording/Disclaimer:** Need to include a disclaimer on the website for reservations of the possibility of no power or other issues due to high water. Grawien suggested the verbiage be less severe and state that the Harbor Commission will continue to monitor water levels and keep people informed. Woerfel is concerned about having a total shutdown of the dock. Kahr is putting an estimate and options together to create a boardwalk and add fill to the main dock. Need to make the Town Board aware and prepared for possible lost revenue.

The dock house will be ok if the water goes up another foot.

Harris will update the Town Board.
