advance by the Town Administrator or Town Chairman.

Position Reports To: Town Administrator/Maintenance Supervisor

Function: Maintenance of Town grounds/roads/facilities, janitorial duties in Town-owned buildings

Duties of Maintenance Employees:

- A. To follow the orders as given by the Town Administrator and Maintenance Supervisor.
- B. To promote a harmonious working relationship among all town employees.
- C. To follow safe practices and use safety devices & equipment at all times.
- D. To exercise good judgment at all times.
- E. Be courteous and respectful to all people.
- F. To be on time and ready for work.
- G. To refrain from accepting gifts of any kind.
- H. To abstain from being under the influence of alcohol and/or all illicit substances when reporting to work, as well as on the job.
- I. To perform various job tasks, some of which are (but not limited to):
 - 1. Operate all equipment in a safe, non-abusive manner.
 - 2. Maintain all Town owned facilities.
 - 3. Perform repairs or maintenance on all Town equipment and buildings.
 - 4. Window washing of town facilities.
 - 5. Through cleaning of Town Center, Library, Town Offices, Town Hall, Noble Square Public Restrooms, Ephraim-Gibraltar Airport Restroom and Office as directed.
 - 6. Occasional unscheduled clean-ups in restrooms, Town Hall, Town Center as directed by Administrator and/or supervisor.
 - 7. Maintain janitorial supplies inventory, provide ordering requirement to supervisor as needed.
 - 8. Open/close graves and maintain cemeteries (reset head stones, snow removal, mowing, etc).
 - 9. Trash collection from parks, public buildings and grounds.
 - 10. Keep trash /recycling receptacles clean.
 - 11. Seasonally set garbage/recycling receptacles.
 - 12. Tree, brush and grass cutting along roads and on public grounds.
 - 13. Assist in maintaining existing roads (cold patch).

- 14. Assure road culverts and storm sewers are maintained and kept open.
- 15. Snow removal on village area sidewalks as necessary.
- 16. Snow plow in areas where County cannot reach or is too difficult.
- 17. Snow removal at all Town facilities (parking lots and sidewalks).
- 18. Lawn mowing, edge trimming, clipping disposal, fertilizing, weed-killing, flower planting and weeding on Public properties.
- 19. Maintain wood-chip pathways, trimming hedges and shrubs etc. on Public properties.
- 20. Maintain and keep clean Town streetlights.
- 21. Maintain and install seasonal road signage.
- 22. Maintain information/regulatory signs on Town roads as needed.
- 23. Maintain/repair/replace street name signs as needed.
- 24. Maintain sign retro-reflectivity inventory.
- 25. Maintain bi-annual Paser road ratings.
- 26. Maintain public wood benches.
- 27. Seasonal installation and removal of dock ramps, ice eaters, etc.
- 28. Complete and turn in required paperwork in a timely fashion.
- 29. Accept job training, when requested and attend job related seminars when requested.
- 30. Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

- A. Self-starter with minimum supervision required.
- B. Good organizational skills to maximize time spent and demonstrate good work ethic.
- C. Good communication skills and the ability to work well with co-workers and the general public.
- D. Good working knowledge of lawn and maintenance skills, equipment operation and safety requirements.
- E. Ability to use and maintain power tools such as riding and push mowers, hedge trimmers, leaf blowers, chain saws etc.
- F. Ability to work outdoors in difficult working conditions such as uneven ground surfaces, in heat, cold, wind rain or snow.
- G. Good cleaning skills for restrooms, offices, etc. thoroughly and as directed; capacity for worst-case scenarios in cleaning situations.
- H. Ability to sit, kneel, bend, stoop, walk, climb, carry as required to complete road, janitorial or grounds maintenance projects.
- I. Maintain a valid driver's license, must possess a clean driving record.
- J. Ability to pick up 50#.
