

Door County Receives National Scenic Byway Recognition

Gibraltar is on the map! The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) recently announced 34 National Scenic Byways and 15 All-American Roads, the first additions to the program since 2009. Door County's Coastal Byway, a Wisconsin Scenic Byway, stretches over 66 miles of the Door Peninsula, beginning just north of the City of Sturgeon Bay, following State Highway 57 north along one side of the Peninsula to Northport and Gills Rock at the very tip, and then traveling south on State Highway 42 back to the starting point. The Town of Gibraltar is among the communities the Door County Coastal Byway travels through.



With this recognition, Door County Coastal Byway joins the ranks of other scenic routes like Maine's Katahdin Woods and California's Historic Route 66.

Established in 1991, the National Scenic Byways Program recognizes roadways with notable scenic, historic, cultural, natural, recreational, and archaeological qualities. These latest additions bring the total of America's Byways® to 184 byways in 48 states.
