Spring Election Updates

The Spring Election is just around the corner on Tuesday, April 6, 2021. Below are important dates and deadlines to keep in mind for those who want to register to vote or vote absentee.

VOTER REGISTRATION

March 17, 2021 - Deadline to register by mail and online. If registering by mail, the registration **form**, along with proof of residence must be postmarked no later than March 17, 2021. Voters who are able to match their name, date of birth, Wisconsin Driver License or State ID number, and address with the Wisconsin DMV can register to vote online using **myvote.wi.gov**.

April 2, 2021 @ 5:00 p.m. - Deadline to register in your municipal clerk's office. Voters may register in-person in their municipal clerk's office during the clerk's business hours until 5:00 p.m. on April 2, 2021.

April 6, 2021 from 7:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. - Voters can register to vote at their polling place on Election Day, April 6, 2021.



VOTING ABSENTEE

Voters must be registered before they can request an absentee ballot and must provide a photo ID with their request. Request an absentee ballot on **MyVote.wi.gov** or download, complete and mail this **form** to PO Box 850, Fish Creek, WI 54212.

April 1, 2021 @ 5:00 p.m. - Deadline to request an absentee ballot for regular and permanent overseas voters. Absentee ballot requests must be received by the municipal clerk no later than 5:00 p.m.

April 2, 2021 @ 5:00 p.m. - Deadline to request an absentee ballot for indefinitely confined voters. Absentee ballot requests must be received by the municipal clerk no later than 5:00 p.m.

April 2, 2021 @ 5:00 p.m. - Deadline to request an absentee ballot for military voters. Absentee ballot requests must be received by the municipal clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 2, 2021.
