Call to Order: Hackbarth called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Members Present: Hackbarth stated that a quorum of the committee was present. Members present Brian Hackbarth via Zoom Conference. Laurie Buske, Andrea Kinsey-Jauquet, and Jayson Merkel in person.

Absent: John Lancaster

Proper Notice/Adopt Agenda: Hackbarth verified the agenda had been properly noticed.

Motion: (Merkel, Buske) to adopt the agenda as posted. Carried.

Approve Minutes of Previous Meeting(s): Motion: (Merkel, Buske) to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2021 meeting as written. <u>Carried</u>.

Public Comment: Myrv Somerhalder commented that the sign in the Blossomberg Cemetery will need to be updated. The year is listed as 1904. He found documents that the Town purchased the cemetery in 1890 from the Andersons for \$50. The Juddville Cemetery was established July 28, 1878 and the Town took it over in 1958.

Reports:

Chair: No report

Gardens: Buske reported the month has been busy. She's been mulching and prepping the gardens. Since we cut the flower budget, may need additional funds for a fall display.

Lighthouse: Blahnik reported the lighthouse festival is this weekend. The Zellners have been a huge help.

Would like a to request a parking permit for the dock.

Invasive Species: Buske reported the detention pond has purple blooming vetch. It is easy to pull and recommends removing it as soon as possible.

Woldt Plaque Request: The Woldt family would like to replace the plaque on the flag pole at the Town Center. Mr. Woldt will determine the cost of the plaque and the Building Committee will inspect the concrete. Motion: (Merkel, Buske) to direct staff to work with Mr. Woldt and come up with better numbers. Carried.

Review Cemetery Rules and Regulations: The State Park has mentioned they would consider allowing the Town to have upright headstones.

Buske is opposed to allowing the upright stones. Will need to look into the future expansion. Hackbarth would prefer to include all areas.

Motion: (Buske, Jauquet) to pursue the 5 acres with upright headstones, leaving the current area with the flush. <u>Carried, Hackbarth Opposed.</u>

Cemetery Bench Donation Request: Jody Gonzales would like to place a bench in Blossomberg Cemetery. *Motion: (Buske, Jauquet) to accept the bench donation with a concrete pad. Carried.*

Fish Creek Beach: The beach will be finished soon. Need to consider playground options and benches. Motion: (Buske, Hackbarth) to ask the Town Board to allow the committee to resume their duties at the beach. <u>Carried</u>.

Hi Kelly,

Maybe we can share at the next Parks & Lands meeting?

I contacted DC Landscape and he will call me to meet when they come to plant the new tree. It sounds like they will plant it by hand so we don't have more equipment moving across the lawn at NS.

I followed up on Dave's Tree Service regarding tree issues pointed out during Building Inspections the past two weeks.

Red Maple (Royal) trees at Clark Park & Old Town Hall These trees are stressed, which is the reason for less full canopy. They are in the Norway Maple family, which makes them extremely hardy. There was no sign of insect damage or diseases.

It appears there is root girdling, where tree roots incircle the trunk and slowly cut off nutrients needed to be healthy. It is a slow process and seems to begin to show up in the less full canopy.

What causes this, planting a maple too deep.

The tree will wrap its roots around the surface, so it doesn't suffocate.

So we may have a few years more and will need to replace them.

I also asked about the Royal Frost Birch tree at Noble Square; I didn't see the one trunk was not leafed out at the crown.

Dave confirmed it has Birch Borer, and treatment would be effective and also watered frequently to help reduce stress. I will be talking to GHA to consider paying for this treatment, and I will volunteer to water the tree as I am in the Square often.
