

**TOWN OF GIBRALTAR  
ORDINANCE 2022-21  
JUVENILE ABBREVIATED FEE AND FORFEITURE SCHEDULE**

---

**Ordinance 2022-21 identified in code 10.40 the code of ordinances, shall repeal and replace any previous ordinance(s) in whole or in part, or any other ordinances contradicting to this new ordinance.**

The Town Board of Gibraltar, in the County of Door, State of Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

**Purpose:**

The Juvenile fee and forfeiture schedule is established as a basis for the Gibraltar Police department for administering forfeitures to minors.

**Definition:**

The term minor will refer to any male or female who has not reached the age of 18 years old.

**Authority:**

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Gibraltar is granted authority for adopting this ordinance under its general 60.10(2)(c) and 60.22(3), Wisconsin Statutes. The Town Board adopts this Ordinance under its general Village Powers authority and 66.1014 of the Wisconsin Statutes, 2917 Act 59.

**Review and Amendments:**

The fees set forth in the Town of Gibraltar Juvenile code of Ordinances may be added to or amended from time to time by adoption of an ordinance. In addition, the Town Board of Gibraltar may review the Juvenile fee and forfeiture schedule on at least an annual basis for the purpose of adjusting and updating the fees and forfeitures charged by the town, and any amendments or additions thereto may be made by resolution of the Town Board.

**Conflict of Provisions:**

The Juvenile fees and Forfeitures set forth in the Juvenile fee schedule shall supersede any fee or forfeiture established elsewhere in the towns code of ordinances for the same charges. If a fee or forfeiture is set forth elsewhere in the Town of Gibraltar's code of ordinances, and there is no corresponding fee or forfeiture set forth in the attached Fee and Forfeiture schedule, the fee or forfeiture set forth elsewhere in the code of ordinances shall control until such time as a fee or forfeiture for the same charge is established in the fee and forfeiture schedule.

**Severability:**

Each of the provisions of the ordinance is severable and if any provision is held invalid for any reason, the remaining provisions shall not be affected but shall remain in full force and effect.
